### *Financial Literacy Grants 2007-08*

Capital One has a strong commitment to education and understands the importance of teaching youth about financial issues. In support of this commitment the Foundation has joined in a partnership with Capital One to provide Financial Literacy Grants for all Henrico County Public Schools.

It is the intent of these grants to provide an avenue for teachers to develop and implement innovative projects, which are based on content related to financial literacy. Submitted grants should target instruction of content related to budgeting, credit, money management or economics, etc. In the upcoming school year **five \$1,000** grants will be awarded to a teacher or team of teachers from Henrico County schools. Grant proposals should be typed, double-spaced, not to exceed four pages and follow the guidelines as stated on the application. Proposals must clearly reflect how students will gain financial literacy through this project and how the student outcomes will be measured.

Applications must be submitted by **September 26, 2007** and will be reviewed by a committee consisting of Foundation board members and Capital One employees. Grants will be awarded by **November 15, 2007**. Funded projects must be implemented during the spring semester. At the conclusion of each funded project, a Capital One Civic Engagement Grant Project Report must be completed, including an account of student outcomes and achievements, as well as information and insights gained and how those insights will affect future teaching efforts.
