All scholarship applications and criteria will be available from school counselors by November 2011. Completed scholarship applications should be submitted to the local School Counseling Department by the specific date designated by the school. It is the responsibility of the student to obtain this due date.

CAPITAL ONE ACCESS OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Criteria: Applicants must show academic improvement during the senior year. Must begin senior year with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75
